How to Apply for Certification in Speech-Language Pathology

Applicants for the **Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology** (CCC-SLP) are evaluated against the <u>2005 Standards for Certification in Speech-Language Pathology</u>.

Initial Application

To begin the application process for your certification, you must first submit these items together:

- Application for Speech-Language Pathology Certification [PDF]
- Dues/Fees Payment using the <u>Dues and Fees Schedule</u> [PDF]

Supplemental Documents

Before completing the certification process, you must also submit the following:

- Passing Praxis exam scores (sent directly to ASHA from ETS)
- Official graduate transcript* which verifies the date and degree awarded (may arrive directly from institution)
- Speech-Language Pathology Clinical Fellowship (SLPCF) Report and Rating Form [PDF] to report Clinical Fellowship experience

Certification Process

Reviewing a completed application and supplemental documentation will usually take about 4-6 weeks; however, we are currently experiencing an unusually high volume of applications, so the reviewing process may take up to 8-10 weeks. You may submit an application anytime after you have completed the necessary coursework, practicum, and received the required graduate degree.
