

How to Apply for Certification in Speech-Language Pathology

Applicants for the **Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology** (CCC-SLP) are evaluated against the [2005 Standards for Certification in Speech-Language Pathology](#).

Initial Application

To begin the application process for your certification, you must first submit these items together:

- [Application for Speech-Language Pathology Certification](#) [PDF]
- Dues/Fees Payment using the [Dues and Fees Schedule](#) [PDF]

Supplemental Documents

Before completing the certification process, you must also submit the following:

- Passing [Praxis exam scores](#) (sent directly to ASHA from ETS)
- Official graduate transcript* which verifies the date and degree awarded (may arrive directly from institution)
- [Speech-Language Pathology Clinical Fellowship \(SLPCF\) Report and Rating Form](#) [PDF] to report [Clinical Fellowship](#) experience

*Applicants applying more than three years after graduation from a CAA-accredited graduate program must submit official undergraduate transcripts reflecting all coursework completed for certification. Internationally educated applicants must submit an original evaluated transcript.

Certification Process

Reviewing a completed application and supplemental documentation will usually take about 4-6 weeks; however, we are currently experiencing an unusually high volume of applications, so the reviewing process may take up to 8-10 weeks. You may submit an application anytime after you have completed the necessary coursework, practicum, and received the required graduate degree.
