\*This data does not include students who may have taken the NCE/CMHCE and passed but did not apply for licensure status in Texas and did not respond to the survey. It is also not known how many students took the exam but did not pass. Summer 2022 graduates are also less likely to have taken the exam at the time that data for this report was compiled.
