Subject: Malign Foreign Talent Recruitment Programs (MFTRPs)

Date: August 5, 2024

The CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 required federal research funding agencies to establish a policy by August 9, 2024, requiring "Covered Individuals" to certify at proposal, and annually thereafter for the duration of the award, that they are not a party to a Malign Foreign Talent Recruitment Program. The CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 also required that the institution (UTEP) certify that Covered Individuals have been made aware of the requirement and have complied with the requirement.

The Department of Defense (DoD) also released <u>Countering Unwanted Foreign Influence in Department-Funded Research at Institutions of Higher Education</u>. This document states that "Beginning August 9, 2024, the DoD is prohibited from providing funding to or making an award of a fundamental research project proposal in which a covered individual is participating in a malign foreign talent recruitment program or to a proposing institution that does not have a policy addressing malign foreign talent programs pursuant to Section 10632 of the CHIPS and Science Act of 2022.

In addition, the CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 directs federal agencies to require senior/key personnel to disclose participation in foreign talent recruitment programs. Information regarding foreign talent recruitment programs can be found on UTEP's Research Security website here. In response to these requirements, UTEP is required to have a policy addressing these programs and prohibit participation in Malign Foreign Talent Recruitment Programs by Covered Individuals. Many of the tenets of these programs conflict with UTEP policy and UTEP Covered Individuals having the capacity to apply for federal funding is an important factor in the sustainability of UTEP's research mission.

Covered individuals: Per the CHIPS and Science Act of 2022, Section 10638, the term "Covered Individual" means an individual who: A. contributes in a substantive, meaningful way to the scientific development or execution of a research and development project proposed to be carried out with a research and development award from a Federal research agency; and B. is designated as a covered individual by the Federal research agency concerned. As indicated by B. above, definitions may vary by agency. For example, DoD has specified that Covered Individuals include those listed as key personnel per the DoD guidance, Countering Unwanted Foreign Influence in Department - Funded Research at Institutions of Higher Education.

False statements or claims (including intentional omissions) in violation of this federal regulation may result in criminal, civil, administrative, or university penalties.
