COURSE SEQUENCE

UTEP and EPCC approved the following course sequence to ensure the highest applicability of credits from <u>EPCC's ADN</u> in Nursing into UTEP's <u>BSN</u> and MSN. Students will begin taking courses at UTEP during the summer semesters while completing their ADN at EPCC. Full matriculation to UTEP will occur upon completion of the ADN and passing the NCLEX exam.

Students must meet with their counselors/advisors on a regular basis to develop a program-of-study and stay informed of course availability and other program requirements. CORE CURRICULUM: All undergraduates at UTEP are required to complete a <u>42-semester credit hour core</u> <u>curriculum</u> before receiving a baccalaureate degree. All courses used to satisfy the core curriculum must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Students who transfer without completing the core curriculum at another Texas institution of higher education, but who have completed blocks within the core, shall receive credit in UTEP's core curriculum for each of the blocks successfully (C or better) completed in the core curriculum of the sending institution.

MATRICULATION INTO BSN

To continue onto the BSN and NURS courses, students will need to have completed their ADN degree, passed their NCLEX exam, and completed all core curriculum requirements.

120 SCH GRADUATION REQUIREMENT: The BSN requires a total of 120 SCH for graduation. Transfer credits will be included in the total count. If a student has fulfilled their core curriculum and nursing requirements, but is still short of completing the 120 SCH requirement, the student will need to complete the remaining SCH in any course that will count towards their electives.
