

SNOA UPDATES FOR CAMPUS

****For ALL new grants and/or additional allocations beginning 03/01/23 forward****

- **Standard Grants**
 - SNOA
 - Scholarship – Not Allowed
 - Tuition Support – Not Allowed
 - Doct. RA Remission – Allowed
 - PhD RA Students only
 - Students MUST be employed by the same project that is paying the SNOA
 - Limit of \$2K per semester
 - Limit of \$1K per semester for last year of school
- **Training/Research Training Grants (T/RTG)**
 - SNOA
 - Scholarship – Allowed
 - Scholarship (for subsistence and travel) – allowed
 - Tuition Support – Allowed
 - Students CANNOT be employed with UTEP if receiving Scholarship or Tuition Support SNOA's
 - Doct. RA Remission – Not Allowed
- Definitions of a Grant
 - Standard grant – a standard grant or contract, regardless of source of funds, is where an employee/employer relationship is developed, and students are paid via salaries and wages. Standard grants or contracts can be for research, instruction, outreach, or public service.
 - Training/Research Training grant (T/RTG) – a T/RTG grant is identified or classified by the funding agency where the recipient of any student support (ex. Fellowship, scholarship, tuition, subsistence, travel and stipends in lieu of salaries/wages) provided under the T/RTG cannot be an employee of the university unless otherwise expressly stipulated and approved by the funding agency under regulatory authority.
